

The Early Years Learning Framework (EYLF) and Australian Curriculum are the mandated curricula for students Preschool to Year 10. The South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE) is the curriculum from Year 10 to the end of schooling.

All students at Kilparrin have a One Plan that describes the adaptations and accommodations for individual students. The purpose of the One Plan is to support access, participation, and achievement in the mandated curriculum.

Individual goals are agreed in collaboration with those involved with each student e.g., teachers, parents and relevant service providers such as Speech Pathologists, Physiotherapists and Occupational Therapists. Specific goals are identified, agreed upon and documented in individual Learning Plans as part of the One Plan process.

Expanded Core Curriculum

The expanded core curriculum (ECC) refers to essential additional specific skills for students who are Deaf/Hard of Hearing (DHH) or Vision Impaired (VI). Each student is unique, and so are the additional skills they will require in order to achieve success in their educational setting.
